The IDEA Scholarship is open to members of ethnic or racial groups historically excluded from and underrepresented in graduate education – Black; Asian American; Indigenous (American Indian/Alaskan Native, Native Hawaiian, or other Native Pacific Islander); Hispanic or Latino/a; Being of a gender and/or sexual orientation or identity historically underrepresented in your field of study; or holding DACA, TPS, refugee, or asylee status.

Additional IDEA Requirements:

- Must have a final cumulative undergraduate GPA of 3.25 or higher from all institutions of previous attendance (undergraduate, graduate, etc.)
- Must have confirmed enrollment at AGS and paid the enrollment fee prior to submitting the scholarship application.
- To receive the scholarship the student needs to register and attend classes.
